Tomorrow, 8 September 2010, President Toomas Hendrik Ilves will begin his official two-day visit to Poland.

President Ilves will have a bilateral meeting with Polish president Bronisław Komorowski, with whom he will discuss regional cooperation, particularly in the field of transport connections.

The Estonian head of state will also attend the Krynica economic forum, addressing the audience alongside the Polish president, European Commission president Jose Manuel Barroso and European Parliament president Jerzy Buzek as part of a plenary session entitled "Europe After the Lisbon Treaty: Strategies for the Future".

On 8 September the Estonian president will have a bilateral meeting with European Commission president Jose Manuel Barroso, with whom he will discuss the economic and political future of the European Union in the wake of the global financial crisis.
