The President, Toomas Hendrik Ilves, met today with the Minister of Defence, Urmas Reinsalu, and the Commander of the Defence Forces, General Brigadier Riho Terras, who introduced him to the new 10 year national defence development plan.

The Head of State acknowledged the officials of the Ministry of Defence and officers of the General Staff of the Defence Forces for establishing ambitious – yet realistic – specific, justified and affordable objectives for Estonia's national defence.
