The Cultural Foundation's Young Scientist Award can be awarded to a scientist who is up to 35 years old and holds a PhD degree, and who is a researcher at an Estonian or foreign scientific research establishment or university. The award amounts to 4,800 euros and it is funded by Väino Kaldoja.

Applicants must submit a written statement with their personal data and short résumé (name, address, education, professional activities), a description of their research and a list of their published works. Additionally, references from at least two supervisors or university teachers are required. Applications can be submitted by the candidates themselves, their supervisors, employers, or members of the board of the Cultural Foundation.
